Whereas, the Directorate has approved **M/s. United Marine Academy** [MTI No.204027] at 401, Vindhya Comm. Complex, Sector 11, CBD Belapur, Navi Mumbai, Thane, Maharashtra- 400614. The DGS has granted approval to conduct the following maritime courses:

2. Whereas, **M/s. United Marine Academy** [MTI No.204027] vide letter No. UMAT/GEN/009/2025 dated 12.07.2025 has informed their voluntary discontinuation of training operation **with effect from 31st August 2025** and requested for **closure of their Institute**. The management has concluded that the training operations will be brought to a formal closure from **31st August 2025**.

The following key points have been confirmed by the Institute:

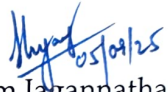
1. No new batches are scheduled beyond the closure date.
2. All student records, assessments, and certification data have been duly updated to the DGS e-Governance portal.
3. The Institute will retain training and certification records as per the prescribed retention period.
4. Tie-up institutes utilizing their swimming pool facilities have been given Formal 1 month notice to make alternate arrangements

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3. **Whereas**, the matter was discussed in the 56th STCW Compliance Board Meeting held on 10.07.2025 and the request for closure of the Institute was accepted by the STCW Compliance Board.

4. As the MTI has informed that they have closed the Institute w.e.f 31.08.2025 and voluntarily decided further not to undertake any DGS approved course. Therefore, the undersigned, as per DGS Order 05 of 2016 and in exercise of the powers of supervision of maritime training as provided in Rule 75 of the Merchant Shipping (Standards of Training Certification and Watch Keeping for Seafarers) Rule, 2014 notified under Section 78. 87, 88, 98, 456. 457 and 458 of Merchant Shipping Act. 1958, as amended withdraws all the approvals granted to the " **M/s. United Marine Academy**, Navi Mumbai" w.e.f the issuance of this letter.
