**ORDER OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL AND DE-RECOGNITION
OF INSTITUTE**

Whereas, the Directorate has approved M/s. CMC Maritime Academy Mumbai [MTI No. 204083] as Post-sea Institute 203, 204 & 205, Second Floor, Haware Infotech Park, Plot No 39/3, Sector 30 A, Vashi, Navi Mumbai, Maharashtra-400703. The DGS has granted approval to conduct the following maritime courses:

2. Whereas, M/s. CMC Maritime Academy Mumbai vide letter No. CMCUM/DGS/012 dated 16.06.2025 has informed for **closure of their Institute**. The Trustees of S.I. Nathan Charitable Trust held the board meeting on 14.06.2025 and resolve the following:

(i) Due to non-viability to operate the "CMC Maritime Academy Mumbai-400703, they have resolved to surrender DGS approval of all the courses and **close the MTI w.e.f. 30.06.2025**.

(ii) Resolve to apply to DGS for closure of the MTI.

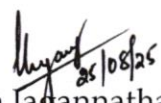
(iii) Resolve to revoke the lease deed with lessor.

3. Whereas, the matter was discussed in the 55th STCW Compliance Board Meeting held on 10.07.2025 and the request of MTI for surrender of all approvals and closure of the Institute, was accepted by the STCW Compliance Board.

4. **Whereas**, the Directorate vide para 5.1 of DGS Order 05 of 2016 has stated "Where after the approval of the DGS. no post-sea competency or modular or simulator course is conducted for a year or more, the DGS approval shall be deemed to have automatically lapsed by default."

5. As the MTI has informed that they have closed the Institute **w.e.f 30.06.2025** and voluntarily decided further not to undertake any DGS approved course. Therefore, the undersigned, as per DGS Order 05 of 2016 and in exercise of the powers of supervision of maritime training as provided in Rule 75 of the Merchant Shipping (Standards of Training certification and Watch Keeping for Seafarers) Rule, 2014 notified under Section 78. 87, 88, 98, 456. 457 and 458 of Merchant Shipping Act. 1958, as amended withdraws all the approvals granted to the " M/s. CMC Maritime Academy, Navi Mumbai " w.e.f the issuance of this letter.
