Show Cause Notice

1. Whereas, Cosmopolitan Technology of Maritime (MTI No. 402008) located at Sengadu Post Ulundai Village Sriperumbadur Taluk (herein after referred as CTM) is a DG Shipping approved Maritime Training Institute (MTI) for conducting Maritime Training Courses.

2. Whereas, MTI vide letter no. File No. 20-19016/27/2020-TRG-DGS dated 17.02.2021 was issued Show Cause Notice for flouting DG(S) guidelines during pandemic. MTI replied to issued Show Cause Notice and same was examined by the Directorate and subsequently Suspension Order was issued to MTI vide letter no. File No. 20-19016/27/2020-TRG-DGS dated 02.06.2021 suspending all the approvals granted to MTI for a period of two months.(Copy attached)

3. Whereas, e-governance team of the Directorate while scrutinizing the batch details submitted by various MTIs has come across that CTM has submitted batch details more than the approved intake capacity.

4. Whereas, as per DGS guidelines following are the mandatory requirements to conduct maritime courses by the institute:

- i) Approval from the Directorate to conduct the course.
- ii) Faculty load Matrix.
- iii) Infrastructure like classrooms, laboratories and workshops etc.

5. Whereas, it is observed that CTM has been regularly flouting the DG(S) guidelines one way or other. There is no Quality Control implementation w.r.t. Batch upload etc. Further, CTM has conducted batches in excess to capacity approved by Directorate without meeting the guidelines. This falls under the "Major Non-conformity" as per Part V Para 5.3.1 of DGS Order 5 of 2016.

6. Whereas, CTM is approved to conduct Basic Safety Training course with intake capacity of 20 students per batch and 24 batches per year i.e., MTI is approved to conduct 2 batches of 20 students per month. However, as per batch details submitted by CTM, the institute has submitted batch details for two batches in the month of September with one batch having Batch start date 07.09.2022 and Batch end date 19.09.2022 and other having Batch start date 14.09.2022 and Batch end date 26.09.2022. The MTI has submitted batch details of 96 candidates for both of the above mentioned batches; however, MTI is approved only to conduct course for 40 candidates in a month (two batches in a month). Further, CTM has uploaded batch details of 1860 candidates in the year 2022 against the approved capacity of only 480 candidates in a year.

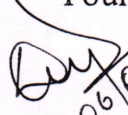
7. In view of the above serious Major non-conformity, the Maritime Training Institute CTM is called upon to Show Cause as to why following disciplinary action should not be initiated;

7.1 Withdrawal/Suspension of all approvals granted to CTM by the Directorate.

7.2 Disciplinary action against the Trust "Cosmopolitan Educational and Social Development Trust", for Major Deficiency and blacklisting the Trust and Trustees from being associated with any kind of business related to the Directorate General of Shipping for a period of five years.

8. Your reply to this Show Cause Notice may be submitted to this Directorate within 15 days from issuance of this Show Cause failing which the actions mentioned above shall be initiated.

9. This Show Cause Notice is issued with the approval of the Director General of Shipping and Additional Secretary to the Government of India in exercise of the powers conferred under the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958 as amended.
