ORDER

Reference:

1. SCN dated 17.02.2026 for Non-Compliance of CIP
2. SCN dated.16.04.2026 for Non-Compliance of CIP and deficiencies in faculty qualifications.

Name of the MTI: M/s. Navigator Maritime Academy [MTI No.108025]

Whereas the MTI Navigator Maritime Academy, was issued Show Cause Notice dated 17.02.2026 for Non-Compliance of Comprehensive Inspection Programme (CIP) by the MTI.

2. Whereas, in reply to the show cause, the MTI vide letter dated 21.02.2026 had stated that due to non-availability of auditors, refusal by certain ROs, and lack of response from others, the inspection could not be scheduled. The MTI had also submitted that it approached MMD Kandla; however, due to scheduling constraints, the inspection could not be finalized. The MTI has attributed the delay to circumstances beyond its control and had requested guidance/authorization for conducting the CIP inspection.

The explanations submitted by the MTI were not found satisfactory, as CIP inspections are required to be planned and completed in a time-bound manner in accordance with DGMA directives.

3. Whereas, the CIP inspection initiated by MMD Kandla on 06.03.2026, indicated that the MTI was operating without complying with the requirement of permanent faculty both in terms of number and qualification for the courses that they have been approved by the DGS. It was observed that personnel qualified to be 'instructors' in a DGS approved MTI were engaged as 'faculty' which is a violation of the extant DGS Orders issued. The CIP inspection was 'suspended' by the attending surveyor

for existence of deficiencies which are considered as '**Major Deficiencies**' as per the Para 5.3.1.1 of the DGS Order No. 5 of 2016.

4. Whereas, the matter was taken up before the STCW Compliance Board Meeting and the Board, in view of the detection of the major deficiencies, together with the continued reluctance of the MTI from actively pursuing and completing the CIP inspection within the timelines mandate, has put for the following direction:

- a) all Course approval granted to the MTI, M/s. **Navigator Maritime Academy, Agra** shall cause to be suspended with immediate effect.
- b) M/s. **Navigator Maritime Academy, Agra** is hereby directed to submit its written reply within seven (7) days from the date of issuance of this Notice, showing cause as to why:
 - (i) the DGS approval should not be withdrawn forthwith; and
 - (ii) disciplinary and administrative action should not be initiated against the Institute for violations of the DGS Orders and Training Circulars.

5. Whereas, accordingly, action was initiated and **Show Cause Notice dated 16.04.2026** was issued to the MTI with the direction to submit the detailed action plan with details of faculty designated for each course, indicating the designated course-in charge for each of these courses the faculty name, FIN no, appointment letter etc.as per the Annexures of the DGS Order No.5 of 2016 for evaluating the effectiveness of any corrective action plan.

6. Whereas, the MTI vide **Letter dated 21.04.2026** had submitted all the relevant documents and explanation, in response the SCN dated 16.04.2026, and the same was forwarded to MMD Kandla for examination and verification of compliance submitted by the MTI.

7. Whereas, MMD Kandla vide **email dated 13.08.2026** has informed that Comprehensive Inspection Programme (CIP) of the MTI was carried out on 09.07.2026 and deficiencies previously observed have been rectified. MTI 'Navigator Maritime Academy', Agra (MTI No.108025) is compliant with DGMA Orders, Training Circular and faculty requirements. Upon satisfactory inspection, the CIP Certificate dated 11.08.2026 has been endorsed with **Grade A2**, reflecting an aggregate score of 80.23% for the approved modular courses.

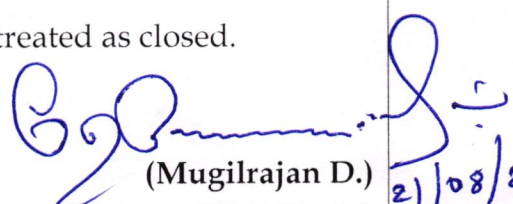
8. Considering the above CIP Report and compliance with all deficiencies, the Competent Authority has decided to **revoke the suspension** with immediate effect

and permit the Institute 'Navigator Maritime Academy' to conduct the approved courses as below:

10. The Show Cause Notice issued in the matter is to be treated as closed.
