ORDER

1. M/s. Cosmopolitan Technology of Maritime (MTI No. 402008), situated at Sengadu Post, Ulundai Village, Sriperumbudur Taluk, Kancheepuram, Tamil Nadu – 602002, run by Cosmopolitan Educational and Social Development Trust and represented by its Director, Dr. N. Vijayakumar, was approved to conduct the GP Rating Course;
2. And whereas, the Hon'ble High Court of Madras, vide judgment dated 20.08.2026 in W.A. No. 3347 of 2025, directed publication of the results of the 80 additional students admitted to the GP Rating Course in the January 2025 batch who had appeared for the examination conducted on 19.12.2025;
3. And whereas, the Hon'ble High Court further directed that, thereafter, an independent evaluation be conducted to ensure that the said students had acquired the requisite practical knowledge and completed the necessary training and, upon satisfaction thereof, those students who were successful in the results so published be permitted to receive their Course Completion Certificates;
4. And whereas, in pursuance of the aforesaid judgment, this Directorate issued the Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026, providing for publication of the withheld results and prescribing the procedure and modalities for the subsequent independent evaluation;
5. And whereas, pursuant to the Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026, the results of the examination conducted on 19.12.2025 were published and, on the basis thereof, 54 candidates were found eligible for the independent evaluation prescribed under the said Speaking Order;
6. And whereas, an Independent Evaluation Committee comprising six members was constituted in accordance with the Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026, with nominated officers of MMD Chennai functioning as Observers;
7. And whereas, the independent evaluation of the eligible candidates was conducted on 16.09.2026 at AMET University, Chennai, in accordance with the Standard Operating Procedure prescribed under Annexure-II to the Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026;

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8. And whereas, the Report of the Independent Evaluation Committee, together with the candidate-wise assessment sheets, attendance records, facilities checklists, declarations and other records generated during the evaluation, has been received by MMD Chennai and forwarded to this Directorate for further necessary action on 17.09.2026;

9. And whereas, out of the 54 candidates eligible for the independent evaluation, 50 candidates appeared and were assessed and 04 candidates remained absent. The Independent Evaluation Committee, upon completion of the assessment, recorded 42 candidates as "Satisfactory" and 08 candidates as "Not Satisfactory";

10. And whereas, the candidate-wise results of the BEST Exit Examination conducted on 19.12.2025 and the outcome of the independent evaluation conducted on 16.09.2026 have been considered with reference to the directions of the Hon'ble High Court and the procedure prescribed in the Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the judgment dated 20.08.2026 in W.A. No. 3347 of 2025 and in continuation of the Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026, the following orders are hereby issued:

12. The candidates have been categorised into the following two lists appended to this Order:

(i) **Annexure-I** – Candidates who successfully cleared the BEST Exit Examination conducted on 19.12.2025 and were subsequently assessed as "Satisfactory" in the independent evaluation conducted on 16.09.2026.

(ii) **Annexure-II** – Candidates who did not qualify at either stage or who remained absent from the independent evaluation, comprising:

(a) candidates who were recorded as "FAIL" in the BEST Exit Examination as published vide Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026;

(b) candidates who, having qualified in the BEST Exit Examination, were assessed as "NOT SATISFACTORY" in the independent evaluation conducted on 16.09.2026; and

(c) candidates who were eligible for the independent evaluation but were absent on 16.09.2026.

13. The candidates included in Annexure-I have successfully completed both stages prescribed pursuant to the judgment dated 20.08.2026, namely, the BEST Exit Examination and the subsequent independent evaluation. Accordingly, the candidates listed in Annexure -I shall be issued the Course Completion Certificate for the GP Rating Course, subject to completion of the applicable formalities.

14. The candidates included in Annexure -II, having either failed the BEST Exit Examination, failed to attain a "Satisfactory" outcome in the independent evaluation, or remained absent from the independent evaluation, shall not be issued the Course Completion Certificate and M/s. Cosmopolitan Technology of Maritime shall refund the applicable fees and charges to the said candidates.

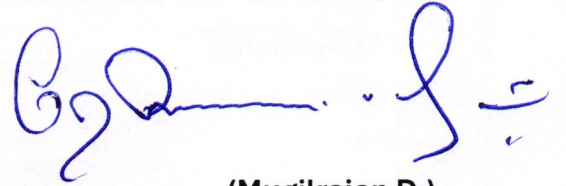
15. The MTI shall complete the refund to the concerned candidates within 7 working days from the date of this speaking order, and shall furnish candidate-wise details of the refunds made, together with documentary proof thereof, to the Directorate.

16. The MTI shall maintain complete and auditable records of the refunds made to the concerned candidates. Failure to comply with the above directions shall invite appropriate regulatory action in accordance with the applicable provisions.

17. The Annexure -I and Annexure -II appended to this Order form an integral part of this Order and shall be read together with the Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026 wherein necessary directions have been already issued to the MTI in the earlier order towards refund of the applicable fees and charges to the candidates who were recorded as "FAIL" in the BEST Exit Examination as published vide Speaking Order dated 10.09.2026.

18. This Order is confined to the candidates covered by the proceedings relating to the 80 additional candidates of the January 2025 GP Rating batch of M/s. Cosmopolitan Technology of Maritime and shall not be construed as retrospective approval, ratification or regularisation of the excess admission and is in pursuance of the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras dated 20.08.2026 in W.A. No. 3347 of 2025 .

19. M/s. Cosmopolitan Technology of Maritime shall comply with the above directions forthwith and extend all necessary cooperation to MMD Chennai and the Directorate for completion of the consequential formalities.
